SUMMARY ORDER

NOW on this 20 day of June, 2017, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Legacy Pharmacy ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board has previously issued Respondent Registration No. 22-16456, which entitles Respondent to function as a pharmacy in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
2. The Board previously issued Respondent a Summary Order with required fine payment of \$15,000 on January 6, 2017 under case number 16-144.
3. Respondent was given 30 days to pay the required fine of \$15,000, or until February 6, 2017.

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4. Respondent was allowed up to 15 days to file an appeal for reconsideration of the Summary Order with the Board, or until January 21, 2017.

5. To-date, Respondent has not contacted the Board in any capacity regarding an appeal or payment of the 16-144 Summary Order.

6. To-date, Respondent has not paid any amount of the required fine of \$15,000.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(e)(1), the Board may revoke, suspend, place in probationary status or deny a renewal of the registration of a pharmacy upon a finding that Such pharmacy has been operated in such manner that violations of the provisions of the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas.

8. Respondent's failure to comply with the 16-144 Summary Order, which concluded Respondent violated provisions of the pharmacy practice act and relevant regulations, is a basis to revoke Respondent's registration to operate as a non-resident pharmacy pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(e)(1).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's registration to operate as a non-resident pharmacy in the State of Kansas is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

1. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

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2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.




