SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 14 day of January, 2019, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Alexandria Alexander, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-102018 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
2. On or about October 8, 2018, the board received information that Respondent had been arrested for theft of property or services on October 5, 2018.

3. On October 26, 2018, the Board mailed Respondent a letter requesting she submit a Personal History Form S-150 to explain the offense, as well as any court documents related to the offense.

4. On December 18, 2018, the Board mailed Respondent a second letter requesting she submit a Personal History Form S-150 to explain the offense, as well as any court documents related to the offense.

5. In mid-December of 2018, the Board received additional information that Respondent had been arrested on March 10, 2018 for possession of a hallucinogenic drug and driving while suspended.

6. On December 28, 2018, the Board mailed Respondent a final letter requesting she submit a Personal History Form S-150 to explain the October offense, as well as the March offense.

7. To date, the Board has not received any of the requested documentation from the Respondent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

9. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627 (a)(15), the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist if the pharmacist “has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives any information legally requested by the board.”

10. Respondent's failure to supply the Board with the requested documentation regarding her updated criminal history is a violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

11. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

12. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

13. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

14. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:


