SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

Registration No. 14-01451

BEFORE THE KANSAS BOARD OF PHARMACY

NOW on this day of November, 2018, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Glenna Van Horn, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Board has previously issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-01451 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On or about June 12, 2018, the Board received notification that Respondent had been arrested on June 11, 2018.

- 3. On or about June 18, 2018, the Board sent Respondent a letter requesting she submit a Criminal Background Check Form S-100 and fingerprint card.
- 4. On August 2, 2018, the Board sent Respondent a second letter requesting she submit a Criminal Background Check Form S-100 and fingerprint card.
- 5. On August 28, 2018, the Board received a voicemail from Respondent stating that the June 11, 2018 arrest stemmed from a previous offense that she had disclosed on her renewal application. The Board responded via email stating that Respondent needed to submit the Form S-100 and fingerprint card regardless of what the arrest stemmed from.
- 6. On October 5, 2018, the Board sent Respondent a final letter requesting she submit a Criminal Background Check Form S-100 and fingerprint card.
- 7. To date, the Board has not received the requested Background Check Form S-100 or fingerprint card.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 8. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.
- 9. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627 (a)(15), the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist if the pharmacist "has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives any information legally requested by the board."
- 10. Respondent's failure to supply the Board with the requested documentation is a violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15).

<u>ORDER</u>

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

- 11. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
- 12. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 13. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
- 14. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
