AGENCY ORDER

On April 23, 2010, the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") issued a *Final Agency Order* in this case (the "2010 Order"). The 2010 Order suspended the Kansas license to practice pharmacy of William L. Pollard, R.Ph. ("Respondent"), required Respondent, among other things, to enter into an agreement with the Kansas Pharmacists Association Committee on Impaired Pharmacy Practice ("CIPP") and to appear before the Board at its meeting on June 10, 2010. Respondent appeared at the Board's June 10, 2010 meeting. With Respondent's agreement, a motion was made, seconded and passed by the Board to modify the 2010 Order by removing the suspension of Respondent's Kansas license to practice pharmacy while leaving all other aspects of the 2010 Order unchanged. Thereafter, a Stipulation and Final Agency Order was prepared to journalize the Board's action at its June 10, 2010 meeting. The Stipulation and Final Agency Order was twice sent to Respondent for his approval, which he has never provided.

It is hereby ordered that the 2010 Order is modified to remove the suspension of Respondent's Kansas license to practice pharmacy. It is further hereby ordered that all other aspects of the 2010 Order, including, but not limited to, the requirement that Respondent remain in full compliance with his CIPP agreement, shall remain unchanged.

Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

1. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

2. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:


