General PMP Update

KTRACS Patient Queries (January 2015 Snap Shot):

- Web (In-state) Requests: 1,141 per day
- Web + PMPi Requests: 4,389 per day (includes Via Christi)



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General PMP Updates

- Added Oklahoma to Kansas data sharing through PMPi in January.
- Mailed out **433** K-TRACS intro letters to new licensees (86 nurses, 30 pharmacists, 301 doctors & PA's, 16 dentists).
- 4Q14 Threshold report generated **247** individuals meeting 5/5/90.
- Top patient meeting threshold (5/5/90) visiting most **PHYSICIANS:**
22 Physicians/ 5 Pharmacies/ 24 Prescriptions (Q4 2014)
23 Physicians/ 15 Pharmacies/ 27 Prescriptions (Q3 2014)

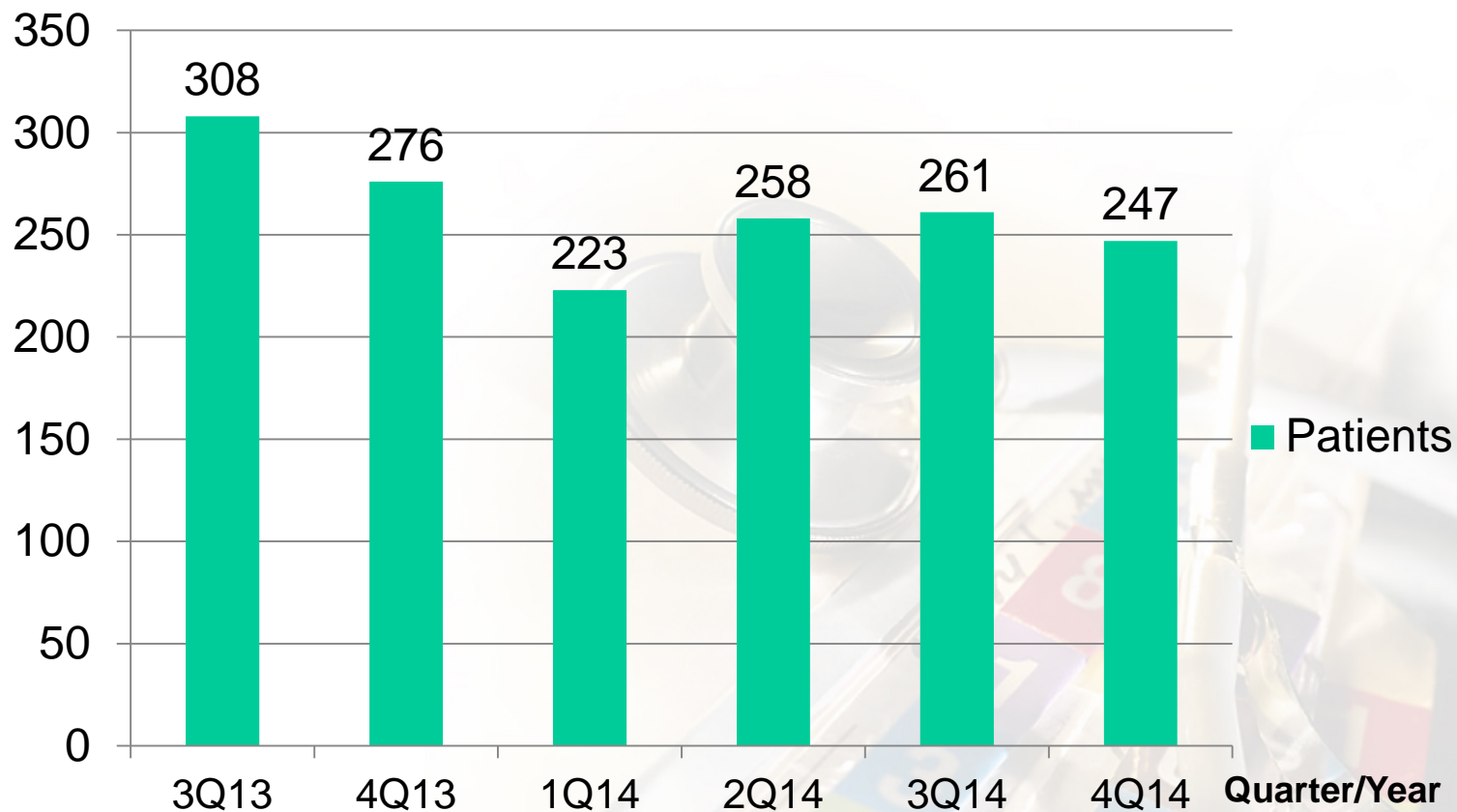


PMP Data Submitter's Reporting Compliance

- Administrators can update pharmacy information and set custom submission rules for each pharmacy.
 - Need to review accuracy of filing frequency for all pharmacies before mailing delinquent letters.
 - Continue to send PMP reporting requirement inserts with all new resident and non-resident pharmacy licenses.

Kansas PMP Initiatives

Harold Rogers Grant Scope Change

- KDADs partnering with KBOP to assist with patients hitting PMP 5/5/90 threshold (rehabilitation /counseling). We are working on the MOU and budget.
 - System Automation provided quote for developing software for automatic K-TRACS registrations for licensees. Would include physicians, nurses and pharmacists. Estimated Cost \$ 30,000 - \$50,000.
 - Goal is to submit scope change with narrative and budget to BJA by the end of February.
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Kansas PMP Initiatives

KHIN (Kansas Health Information Network)

- MOU has been signed with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy.
- Tech partner was 20-30% along in development in November.
- Original plan was to “piggyback” on Via Christi connection.
- Informed by Appriss that this type of connection could only be temporary; Via Christi and KHIN need to have separate web service accounts.
- Appriss suggested ideal connection for KHIN => Direct to Gateway.
- KHIN will need to complete a new Letter of Agreement with Appriss before the PMPi account will be set up. Conference call scheduled with KHIN next week to determine status.
- ICA in process going to leadership to develop new web service model to interface directly with Gateway and determine cost and timeline.



Kansas PMP Initiatives

LACIE (Lewis And Clark Information Exchange)

- Recent change in project lead personnel for the software vendor.
- Planned to start testing in January but KBOP raised concerns that necessary security requirements were not in place.
- Will work with Via Christi as resource and continue weekly calls with KBOP/Cerner/Appriss.
- Estimating to start first hospital pilot in early March.
- Eight ER Physicians/APRNs have been registered and approved for the pilot at Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City.



Kansas PMP Initiatives


Retail Chain Pharmacy

- Have confirmed grant funds are still available and can be moved into second year of grant. A total of \$162,000 has been set aside for this effort.
- Will still need to get “prior-authorization” approval from Dept. of Administration to proceed once MOU signed.
- Had several e-mail/phone conversations with Kroger to determine status. Currently being reviewed by Board of Pharmacy outside legal counsel.
- SAMHSA has approved plan to pass grant funds on to Kroger.
- Ohio is the other state working with Kroger.
- Proposed completion date of 6/30/2016.

Via Christi Hospital Update

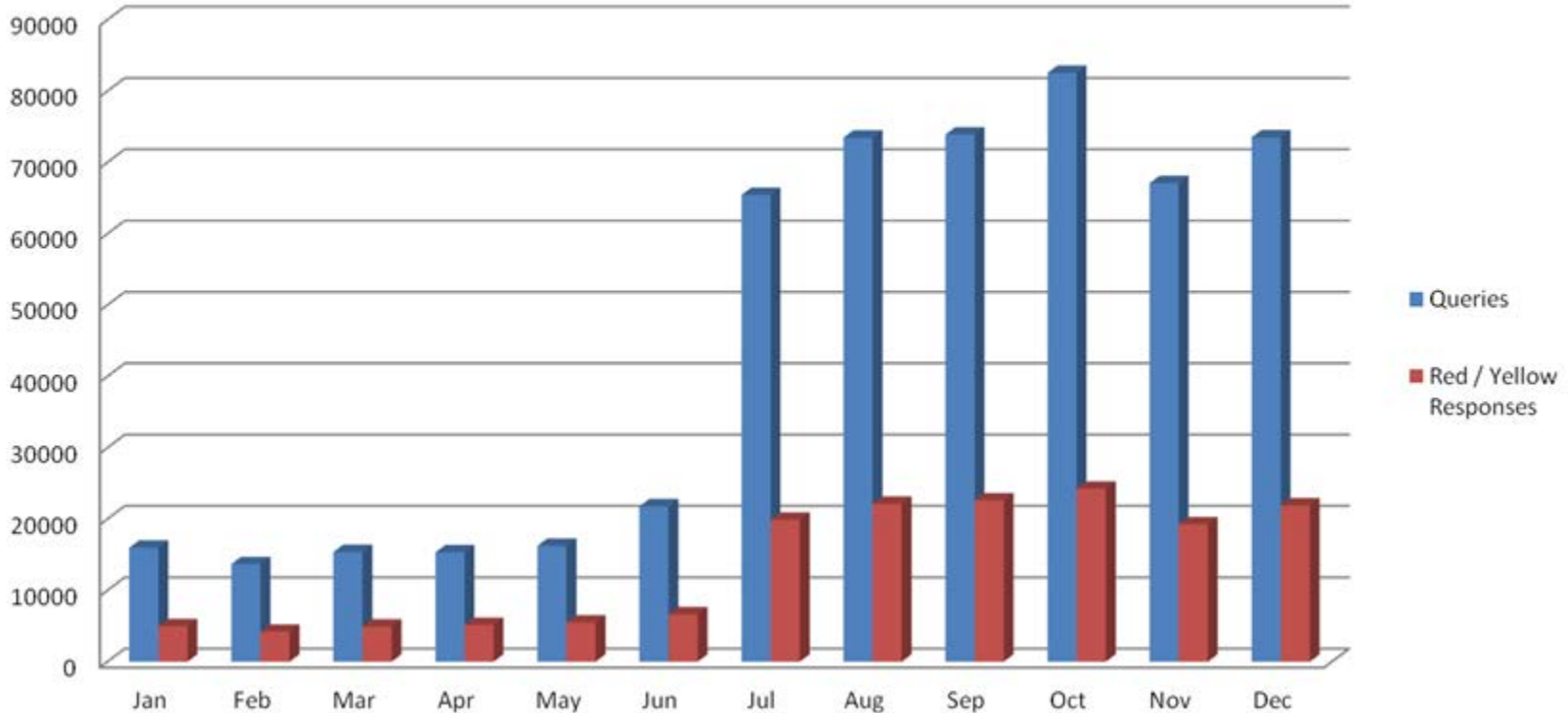
- ❖ Went live on June 1, 2014.
