## SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

**NOW** on October 12, 2023, comes before the Kansas State Board of Pharmacy through its Executive Secretary (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") the matter of Bereket Araya (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the renewal materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions, and order:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board has previously issued Respondent Pharmacist License Number 1-16647 ("Respondent's License") to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Kansas.

2. On or around June 27, 2023, Respondent submitted a renewal application for Respondent's License.

3. In the renewal application, Respondent requested to renew the license on active status.

4. At the end of the renewal application, Respondent agreed to the following statement prior to submitting the completed renewal application: "I hereby attest that I have completed all continuing education hours required by law to renew my license."

5. Respondent's renewal application was selected for an audit to provide proof of Respondent's continuing education certificates or a transcript of completion of required hours.

6. Respondent's NABP CPE Monitor showed completion of 22.75 hours of continuing education to renew Respondent's License.

7. On or about August 16, 2023, the Board sent Respondent an email to Respondent's address of record requesting proof of Respondent's continuing education hours earned for the renewal period ending June 30, 2023 by a specified date.

8. On or about September 6, 2023, the Board sent a letter to Respondent's mailing address of record requesting this information.

9. On or about September 19, 2023, the Board sent a final request letter to Respondent's mailing address of record requesting this information.

10. On or about September 20, 2023, the Board sent Respondent a final email to Respondent's address of record requesting a response no later than October 2, 2023.

11. To date, the Board has not received any response from Respondent regarding the continuing education audit.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

12. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(1), the Board may deny, revoke, suspend, or place on probation any pharmacist license upon a finding that Respondent renewed or attempted to renew a license by false means, including misrepresentation.

13. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(9), the Board may deny, revoke, suspend, or place on probation any pharmacist license upon a finding that Respondent failed to comply with the continuing education requirements of the Board for license renewal.

14. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15), the Board may deny, revoke, suspend, or place on probation any pharmacist license upon a finding that Respondent failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives any information legally requested by the Board.

15. Pursuant to K.A.R. 68-1-1b, 30 hours of continuing education shall be required for renewal

of a pharmacist license during each licensure period, which must be obtained in the two-year licensure period ending on the June 30 expiration date of each license.

16. Respondent was required to provide proof of completion of 30 hours of continuing education earned between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2023.

17. By only having 22.75 hours of continuing education, Respondent failed to complete the required 30 hours of continuing education for renewal of Respondent's License in violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(9).

18. Respondent falsely attested on the renewal application that Respondent had completed all continuing education hours required by law to renew Respondent's license, in violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(1). Though material, the Board makes <u>no finding</u> about whether Respondent's misrepresentation was intentional.

19. Respondent's failure to supply the Board with the requested documentation regarding proof of continuing education is a violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15) and a basis to revoke Respondent's License.

#### **ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's License is hereby REVOKED.

#### **NOTICES**

Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

1. Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231, within 15 days after service of this Order. If the outcome of the hearing is adverse to Respondent, costs of the proceedings shall be charged to Respondent.

2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Summary Order shall become a final

order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

3. Within 15 days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-613. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
