SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING LICENSE REGISTRATION

NOW on this day of September, 2017, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Investigation Member, the matter of Tammy Peterson, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-15240 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On October 21, 2016, Respondent submitted her Pharmacy Technician License Renewal Application online to the Board's website.

- 3. On October 27, 2016, Respondent's payment of \$20.00 was returned as not having sufficient funds.
- 4. On January 5, 2017 the Board requested that Respondent submit a new registration fee payment check of \$20 in addition to a \$30 fee for the returned check having nonsufficient funds.
- 5. On January 27, 2017, the Board sent a second request to Respondent requiring immediate action and payment.
- 6. On August 17, 2017, the Board sent a final notice of required payment to Respondent.
- 7. On August 21, 2017, the final was returned to the Board marked as "Not Deliverable" by the U.S. Postal Service.
- 8. To date, the Board has not received a new registration fee payment from Respondent or any other communication.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663, the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.
- 2. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663(b) each application for pharmacy technician shall be accompanied by an application fee affixed by the Board as provided in K.S.A. 665-1645.

3. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(8), the Board may revoke a license to a pharmacist if a licensee is found by the board to have violated any of the provisions of the Pharmacy Act of the State of Kansas.

4. Respondent's failure to pay the \$50 for her application and nonsufficient funds fee, as required by the Pharmacy Act of the State of Kansas, is grounds to revoke Respondent's registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(8).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED. Further, the Board orders that Respondent shall submit payment of the past due amounts of \$20 and \$30 (\$50 total), which shall be paid to the Board by October 5, 2017.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

- 5. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
- 6. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 7. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

8. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
