SUMMARY ORDER OF DENIAL

NOW on this 4th day of January, 2016, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”), through its Investigation Member, the application of Richard W. Trowbridge (the “Applicant”) for registration as a Kansas pharmacy technician.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board’s Investigation Member enters this Summary Order of Denial in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the application materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board’s Investigative Member makes the following findings of fact:

1. On August 18, 2015 the Board received Applicant’s application for registration as a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas (“Applicant’s Application”).
2. As part of the Applicant’s Application he answered “Yes” to the question: “Have you ever been cited, charged with, or convicted of the commission of any crime; offense; or violation of the law in any state or by the federal government, even if those charges were dismissed, suspended, diverted or expunged?”

3. On August 27, 2015 a representative of the Board wrote Applicant asking for further information regarding one of the prior convictions disclosed in Applicant's Application. Applicant has never provided the Board with the information requested in the August 27, 2015 letter.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

5. That, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627 (a)(15), the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist if the pharmacist "has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives any information legally requested by the board."

6. The Applicant's failure to respond the request by a representative of the Board for further information regarding a prior conviction is a basis to deny Applicant's Application.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Applicant's Application is hereby DENIED.

NOTICES

The Applicant is hereby notified as follows:

7. The Applicant may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas State Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

8. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Applicant's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.


9. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
