If you disagree with the findings of fact, you have the right to request a hearing. Instructions for filing a written request are included under the "Notices" section of the order. Hearings are held before the full Board during their regularly scheduled quarterly meetings.

According to KSA 65-1627h, the Board is required to recoup the costs of administrative hearings when the decision is adverse to the licensee. These costs may include charges for services rendered by the Board's disciplinary counsel, an administrative law judge, and, if applicable, a court reporter.

SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 11th day of May 2023, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Richard Wilson, (“Applicant”), as a Kansas pharmacist.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board’s Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the application materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board has previously issued Applicant pharmacist license 1-12516 (Applicant’s License).
2. On June 24, 2022, the Board received Applicant’s application for renewal of Applicant’s License (“Applicant’s Application”).
3. Applicant answered “No” to the following question on Applicant’s Application: “Has there been a denial, revocation, suspension, voluntary surrender, or any other disciplinary action taken by the State of Kansas or any other jurisdiction against any professional or occupational license or registration held by you?”

4. The Board received information regarding disciplinary action against Applicant imposed by the Oregon Board of Pharmacy on February 17, 2022, against Applicant's Oregon pharmacist license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, the Board may assess a civil fine not to exceed \$5,000, after notice and an opportunity to be heard, to any registrant for violation of the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas or any other rules or regulations of the state board of pharmacy.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(1), the Board may take action against the license of any pharmacist upon a finding that the licensee has obtained, renewed or reinstated, or attempted to obtain, renew or reinstate, a license by false or fraudulent means, including misrepresentation of a material fact.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(8), the Board may take action against the license of any pharmacist upon a finding that the licensee has violated any of the provisions of the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas or any rule and regulation adopted by the board pursuant to the provisions of such pharmacy act.

4. That pursuant to K.A.R. 68-7-25, each pharmacist shall notify the board in writing of any of the following circumstances within 30 days of the date of occurrence: any denial, limitation, suspension, revocation, voluntary surrender, or other disciplinary action taken by another jurisdiction against any pharmacy, pharmacist, pharmacy intern, or pharmacy technician application, license, registration, or permit held by the registrant or licensee.

5. Applicant's answer of "no" to the disciplinary question(s) on Applicant's Application was a misrepresentation of material fact on an application and a basis to take action against Applicant's License as a violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(1).

6. Applicant's failure to notify the Board of the disciplinary action by the Oregon Board of Pharmacy within 30 days is a violation of K.A.R. 68-7-25 and a basis to take action against Applicant's License as a violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(8).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Applicant is ordered to pay a fine to the Board in the amount of \$500. Applicant has 30 days from the date of this order to pay the fine.

NOTICES

Applicant is hereby notified as follows:


1. Applicant may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is.
