I. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Dr. Mansfield at 11:36 AM.

II. Approval of March Minutes

A motion was made by Mr. Godwin to approve minutes, Mr. Coble seconded. Motion carried.

III. In-Person Meeting Discussion

Ms. Donnelly spoke with the committee about the upcoming meeting schedule and whether to return to in-person meetings. She will be sending out to the committee a short survey regarding times and whether to keep the shorter meetings on a virtual platform.

IV. Kansas Opioid Vulnerability Assessment

Ms. Donnelly presented the Kansas Opioid Vulnerability Assessment completed in October 2020 that was CSTE funded with analysis done by Tufts University. The assessment analyzed variables associated with increased risk for opioid-related mortality. Twenty-one Kansas counties were identified as part of the study.

Dr. Long made a motion that all the providers discussed in the top five lists who had zero K-TRACS queries be sent a letter telling them the assets of using the system. Mr. Godwin seconded the motion. Motion carried.
