I. Call to Order	David Schoech, RPh, called the meeting to order at 11:32am.
II. Approval of Minutes	The minutes from the November 4, 2022, meeting were approved. Van Coble, RPh moved, seconded by Joe Davison, MD.
III. Election of Committee Chairperson	Joe Davison, MD, moved, seconded by Van Coble, RPh to elect David Schoech, RPh, as committee chairperson for 2023. The motion was approved.
IV. Adopt Guidance Document for K-TRACS Review and Referral	Ms. Donaldson provided an overview of the case review and referral document. Harold Godwin, RPh moved, seconded by Dr. Davison to adopt the guidance document as presented. The guidance document was further revised to reflect a narrowing of criteria for potential patients of concern. Harold Godwin, RPh moved, second by Joe Davison, MD, to amend his motion to reflect the changes in patient of concern criteria. The motion was approved to accept the amendment. The original motion was approved.
V. Missouri PDMP Update	Dean Linneman, executive director of the Missouri Joint Oversight Task Force for PDMP, provided an update on the Missouri statewide PDMP. Mr. Linneman stated he anticipates an April 1 implementation date. He said the current Missouri statute does not allow for information to be shared with other states. Committee members discussed the impact this will have on Kansas healthcare providers.
VI. Presentation on K-TRACS Access by Medicaid Inspector General	Steven Anderson, Medicaid Inspector General, Kansas Attorney General's Office, presented to the committee regarding his request to the legislature for expanded law enforcement access to K-TRACS. Committee members requested additional research into other state laws. Mr. Anderson also requested the committee consider the Office of

	Medicaid Inspector General as a potential referral source for cases that need further investigation since his office is considered a branch of law enforcement.
