Consideration of Temporary KAR 68-7-23:

Regulation Review

The Executive Secretary provided an update concerning drafting KAR 68-7-23 as a direct result of HB 2217, which was signed by the Governor and will become effective July 1, 2017. As a matter of public safety, staff, legislators, and the stakeholder group supporting the legislation felt that time was of the essence in implementing the law through necessary regulations. A temporary regulation was drafted and has been approved by the Department of Administration and Attorney General, and, upon approval by the Board, will be reviewed for approval by the State Rules and Regulations Board on the 19th.

68-7-23 Emergency Opioid Antagonists

- Statewide protocol signed by one authorizing physician on behalf of state (option to use different physician) and one pharmacist dispensing by protocol
- Provide copy of signed protocol to Board, and notice of discontinuation
- Prescribes dispensing, documentation and recordkeeping, storage, and counseling

A motion was made to approve the temporary regulation (Ullom/Schoech). The Board conducted a role-call vote and unanimously approved the regulation.

On behalf of Kansas law enforcement, Ed Klumpp thanked the Board for its fast work and implementation of a temporary regulation.
