SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 12 day of September, 2018, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Miranda Brown, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-102557 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On or about March 27, 2018, the Board received information that Respondent had received a pending theft offense from November 28, 2017, a pending criminal worthless

check offense from December 28, 2017, and a pending possession of controlled substance/paraphernalia offense from January 16, 2018.

3. On or about March 27, 2018, the Board sent Respondent a letter requesting she

submit a Personal History Form S-150 to explain the offenses.

4. On or about May 21, 2018, the Board sent Respondent a second letter requesting

she submit a Personal History Form S-150 to explain the offenses.

5. On or about July 2, 2018, the Board sent respondent a final letter requesting she

submit a Personal History Form S-150 to explain the offenses.

6. To date, the Board has not received any correspondence from Respondent

regarding her updated criminal history.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a

registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy

technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of

a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

8. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627 (a)(15), the Board may take action against the

license of a pharmacist if the pharmacist "has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its

representatives any information legally requested by the board."

9. Respondent's failure to supply the Board with the requested information

regarding her updated criminal history is a basis to revoke Respondent's Registration pursuant

to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15).

<u>ORDER</u>

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's

Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

10. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas

Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy,

800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of

this order.

11. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the

Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board,

effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

12. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file

a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

13. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek

judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated
