SUMMARY ORDER

On March 19, 2010, the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter "the Board") entered a Summary Order in the above captioned case.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent holds a Kansas pharmacy technician registration and permit, and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.
- 2. At all times relevant herein Respondent was employed as a pharmacy technician at Walgreens Pharmacy, Kansas City, Kansas.
- 3. On or around January 5, 2010 and continuing to January 17, 2010, Respondent added unauthorized refills to her own controlled substance prescriptions and billing her third party insurance on some of the occasions. The Respondent's physician verified that she had not authorized four refills. The drugs included diazepam 5 mg and alprazolam 1 mg. Both drugs are Schedule IV controlled substances.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- Respondent's acts of taking possession of the controlled substances as set forth above constitute separate incidents in violation of the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1601 et seq.
- 2. Respondent's violations of the Pharmacy Act are separate incidents of grounds for the suspension or revocation of Respondent's pharmacy technician registration and permit pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 (e)(1) and K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(3) and (11).
- 3. Respondent's acts of taking the controlled substance from the inventory of the pharmacy where she worked as set forth above constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined in K.S.A. 65-1626(gg).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent Angela E. Fuller's pharmacy technician registration and permit be hereby revoked.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

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NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

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- 1. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 900 SW Jackson, Ste. 560, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1231 within (15) fifteen days after service of this Order.
- 2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's registration and permit shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 3. Within (15) fifteen days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
- 4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute.
