AGREED FINAL ORDER OF SURRENDER OF PHARMACIST LICENSE

The defendant, Kirsty Hartley, R.Ph. (“Hartley”), through her counsel, Diane L. Bellquist, and Disciplinary Counsel for the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, Randall J. Forbes, have jointly requested that the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) enter this Agreed Final Order of Surrender of Pharmacy License.

The parties have stipulated, and the Board finds as follows:

1. The Board issued Hartley’s Kansas pharmacist license number 1-16680 (“Kansas License”) on July 28, 2014.
2. On September 8, 2017, the Board’s Investigation Member issued an Emergency Order of Suspension (“Emergency Order”) suspending Hartley’s Kansas License for the reasons and on the grounds stated in the Emergency Order.
3. On September 8, 2017, the Board’s Disciplinary Counsel served a Petition to Revoke, Suspend or Otherwise Limit Licensure (“Disciplinary Petition”) in the above-captioned matter.
4. On September 20, 2017, Hartley, through her counsel, Diane Bellquist, filed a request for hearing on the Emergency Order.

5. On September 25, 2017, Hartley, through her counsel, Diane Bellquist, filed a Petition for Reconsideration related to the Emergency Order (“Reconsideration Motion”).

6. On October 3, 2017, upon the Joint Motion of Hartley’s Counsel and the Board’s Disciplinary Counsel, the Board entered an Order of Stay staying proceedings in this matter.

7. Hartley wishes to conclude this matter by surrendering her Kansas License on the terms provided in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

A. The Board accepts the surrender of Hartley’s Kansas License and it is hereby cancelled.

B. Should Hartley make a future application for a Kansas pharmacist license, this order shall be considered a revocation of Hartley’s Kansas License.


C. The Emergency Order, Reconsideration Request and Request for Hearing are now moot, and no related hearing will be conducted.
