CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER is entered into effective the 17th day of October, 2014 by and between Chris Henington, R.Ph. (the "Licensee") and the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board").

WHEREAS, the Licensee presently holds Kansas license number 1-13153 issued to him by the Board ("Kansas License"); and

WHEREAS, the Board is the state agency empowered to enforce the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.* (the "Act"), including the use of disciplinary actions to suspend, revoke or limit the licenses of Kansas pharmacists who violate the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board's Investigation Member has received certain information, has investigated and has determined that there are reasonable grounds to believe that the Licensee has committed an act or acts in violation of the "Act" and has caused to be filed herein by the Board's Disciplinary Counsel a Petition to Revoke, Suspend or Otherwise Limit Licensure ("Disciplinary Petition") against Licensee's License.

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2014, the Board's Investigation Member issued an Emergency Agency Order suspending Licensee's License until further order of the Board ("Emergency Order").

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2014, Licensee appeared before the Board at which time the pendency of the Disciplinary Petition was taken up and Licensee requested that the Board suspend the effects of the Emergency Order until January 9, 2015 and place his Kansas License on inactive status. The parties anticipate that the Disciplinary Petition or some resolution of it will be taken up at the Board's scheduled meeting on January 9, 2015.


THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration the Licensee and the Board agree and the Board orders that the effect of the Emergency Order shall be suspended until January 9, 2015. The Licensee and the Board further agree and the Board further orders that Licensee's Kansas License shall be on inactive status from the effective date of this order until January 9, 2015. The Licensee and the Board further agree and the Board further orders that on January 9, 2014, the Emergency Order shall again become effective and Licensee's Kansas License shall again be suspended absent some further order of the Board.

IT IS SO ORDERED







