STIPULATION OF FINDING OF FACT AND ORDER

This matter comes before the State Board of Pharmacy for the State of Kansas, this 21st day of November, 1997.

The State Board of Pharmacy appears by Barry Sarvis, President and Presiding Officer; Lori Moore, Vice-President; Dan Katzer, Pharmacist; Vicki Schmidt, Pharmacist; Karla Kneebone, Pharmacist; and Dan Upson, D.V.M., Consumer Representative. Also appearing are Larry Froelich, Executive Secretary, and the attorney for the Board, Dana W. Killinger. Randy L. Hilgers appears personally.

Randy L. Hilgers states that he has been advised of his procedural rights under the Pharmacy Practice Act and Administrative Procedure Act, wherein counsel for the Board advised Randy L. Hilgers of his rights to a formal hearing wherein he had a right to be represented by counsel, call witnesses on his behalf, cross-examine the Board's witnesses and other procedural rights. Counsel further advised Randy L. Hilgers of the statutory sections

of the law which were allegedly violated and the statute giving the Board jurisdiction in this matter. Whereupon Randy L. Hilgers waived his right to a Formal Hearing.

Randy L. Hilgers further states that no issue of fact exists and wishes to stipulate to the following findings of fact and accepts the order of the State Board of Pharmacy, to-wit:

1. Randy L. Hilgers is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Kansas, having License No. 1-09211.

2. That Randy L. Hilgers is the Pharmacist in Charge at Hutchinson Hospital Pharmacy, Registration No. 2-08541, located at 1701 E. 23rd, Hutchinson, KS 67502.

3. That on August 1, 1997, Randy L. Hilgers had not paid his license renewal fee nor furnished evidence to the Board that he successfully completed the required C.E.'s that must be submitted with the license renewal application. K.S.A. 65-1632(a).


4. That from July 1 to August 13, 1997, as the PIC of record for Hutchinson Hospital Pharmacy, said Randy L. Hilgers was practicing pharmacy with a void and/or inactive license, K.A.R. 68-1-1a(a).

The State Board of Pharmacy for the State of Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(8) has jurisdiction and power to revoke, suspend or place on probation and pursuant


to K.S.A. 65-1658, fine said Randy L. Hilgers.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Randy L. Hilgers, License NO. 1-09211, be fined \$50 for violation of paragraph 3, and \$50 for violation of paragraph 4 for a total of \$100, and to take the law exam within 30 days with a score of not less than ~~75%~~ *75% CE 10* *RH*
