SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING LICENSE REGISTRATION

NOW on this 31 day of March, 2016, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Investigation Member, the matter of Pamela Denise Johnson, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Investigation Member enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Investigative Member makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-18231 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On December 21, 2015, the Board received a notification from the State Treasurer's Office that Respondent's registration fee in the amount of \$68.00 was returned due to a closed account.

- 3. On January 11, 2016 the Board requested that Respondent submit a new registration fee payment check on or before January 22, 2016.
 - Respondent failed to respond to the request.
- 5. On February 12, 2016, the Board sent a second and final request to Respondent requiring immediate action and payment by March 15, 2016.
- 6. On March 7, 2016, the second request was returned to the Board marked as "unclaimed" by the U.S. Postal Service.
- 7. To date, the Board has not received a new registration fee payment from Respondent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 8. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663(b) each application for pharmacy technician shall be accompanied by an application fee affixed by the Board as provided in K.S.A. 665-1645.
- 9. Upon applying for her pharmacy technician registration, Respondent attached a check that was returned because of a closed account.
- 10. To date, Respondent has failed to furnish the Board with any information regarding the bad check and has failed to provide a new application payment to the Board. The Respondent's lack of response and failure to remit the proper registration fee is grounds for revocation of her pharmacy technician registration.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED. Further, the Board orders that Respondent should be and

hereby is assessed a \$30 service charge for the returned check, which shall be paid to the Board by Wednesday, May 4th, 2016.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

- 11. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
- 12. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 13. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
- 14. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
