PETITION TO REVOKE, SUSPEND OR OTHERWISE LIMIT LICENSURE

The Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") for its petition to revoke, suspend or otherwise limit the Kansas intern registration of Kyle B. Jones (the "Registrant") to practice as a pharmacy intern, alleges and states as follows:

- 1. The Board is the Kansas agency vested with the authority to carry out and enforce the provisions of the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1626 *et seq.* (the "Act"), including conducting hearings and proceedings to revoke, suspend, limit or otherwise discipline a Kansas license to practice pharmacy.
- 2. The Registrant is presently entitled to practice as a pharmacy intern in the State of Kansas by reason of the Board having issued him Kansas intern registration number 3-06291. At all times relevant hereto, the Registrant has held a current registration to practice as a pharmacy intern in the State of Kansas.
- 3. The Board's Investigation Member has received certain information, has investigated and has determined that there are reasonable grounds to believe that the Registrant has committed an act or acts in violation of the Act that would subject his pharmacy intern registration to discipline pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1676 (d)(1) and K.S.A. 65-1627.

4. While acting as a pharmacist intern, Respondent diverted drugs belonging to his

employer.

5. On information and belief it is alleged that the Registrant is addicted to drugs to

such a degree as to render him unfit to practice as a pharmacy intern.

6. The Registrant has committed an act or acts, including the conduct identified in

paragraphs 4 and 5 above, that would justify disciplinary action against his intern registration

pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1676 (d)(1) and (2) and K.S.A. 65-1627 (a)(3), (4), (5) and (13).

WHEREFORE it is requested that proceedings be initiated, pursuant to the Act and

Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., and that in accordance therewith

findings and conclusions be made that facts exist demonstrating that the Registrant has

committed acts which justify disciplinary action being taken against his Kansas intern

registration and order that Registrant's intern registration be revoked or such other disciplinary

action as shall be determined to be appropriate.
