SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 3 day of April, 2018, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Cynthia Kratina, Pharmacist (“Respondent”).

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board’s Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board’s Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacist Registration Number 1-11395 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacist in the State of Kansas (“Respondent’s Registration”).
2. On or about October 10, 2017, the Board requested Respondent submit a completed S-100 Fingerprinting Card and any court documents related to recent civil

judgments after receiving information regarding a recent civil judgment involving fiduciary abuse.

3. On or about December 27, 2017, the Board emailed a request to Respondent requesting that the S-100 fingerprinting card and court documents be submitted to the Board within 10 days.

4. To date, the Board has not received a response or any other correspondence from Respondent regarding court documents or the completion of an S-100 fingerprinting card.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

6. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627 (a)(15), the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist if the pharmacist “has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives any information legally requested by the board.”

7. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1696(a), the Board may, in connection with any investigation of a holder of a license, request that person be fingerprinting for the purposes of determining whether a person registered with the Board has a criminal history.

8. Respondent’s failure to supply the Board with the requested documentation regarding court documents and the submission of a Form S-100 is a violation of K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

9. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

10. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

11. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

12. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:


