SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 9th day of July, 2015, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Investigation Member, the matter of Starla Wilson, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Investigation Member enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Investigative Member makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-13522 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. During the period of October 2012 through June 3, 2015, Respondent worked as a pharmacy technician in the Walgreens Pharmacy #05769 location in Wichita, Kansas (the "Pharmacy").

3. Respondent has admitted that while working as a pharmacy technician at the Pharmacy, she stole from the Pharmacy hydrocodone and diazepam, controlled substances for

which she did not have a valid prescription and self-administered them.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a

registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy

technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of

a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

5. That the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist for

unprofessional conduct or professional incompetency as set forth in K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(3).

6. That K.S.A. 65-1626 (ccc)(5) defines unprofessional conduct to include the

unlawful possession of drugs.

7. That the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist, pursuant to

K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(13), for self-administering any controlled substance without a practitioner's

prescription order or mid-level practitioner's order. That additionally, the Board may take

action against the license of a pharmacist, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(4), for being addicted

to such a degree as to render the pharmacist unfit to practice the profession of pharmacy.

8. The Respondent's conduct in stealing drugs from her employer and self-

administering the drugs is a basis to revoke Respondent's Registration.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's

Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

9. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas State

Administrative Procedures Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy,

800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of

this order.

10. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the

Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board,

effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

11. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file

a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

12. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek

judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated
