SUMMARY ORDER

NOW this 5 day of December, 2012, the above captioned matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) on the application of Jeffrey Vaughn (“Respondent”) for a Pharmacy Technician Registration. After considering the foregoing, the Board’s Investigative Member, in accordance with the authority granted to him by the Board, enters the following Summary Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has the authority to grant Respondent a Pharmacy Technician Registration.
2. On October 22, 2012, Respondent applied for a Pharmacy Technician Registration with the Board.
3. The Kansas Bureau of Investigation did a criminal background search on Respondent and provided the Board with an Abstract of Criminal History, more commonly known as the RAP Sheet.
4. Respondent’s RAP Sheet documented the following arrests, charges and convictions pertinent to Respondent’s application for registration as a pharmacy technician:

- a. February 24, 2008: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs (violation of K.S.A. 8-1567).
 - b. February 24, 2008: Possession of a Hallucinogenic (violation of K.S.A. 65-4162).
 - c. October 3, 2010: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs (violation of K.S.A. 8-1567).
 - d. June 30, 2011: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs – 3rd Offense; Felony (violation of K.S.A. 8-1567)
5. Pursuant to K.S.A. § 65-1663(e)(1), the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the Board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. § 65-1627, and amendments thereto.
6. Pursuant to K.S.A. § 65-1627(a)(2), the Board may deny a license when “the licensee has been convicted of a felony and the licensee fails to show that the licensee has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust.”
7. Pursuant to K.S.A. § 65-1627(a)(3), the Board may deny a license when “the licensee is found by the Board to be guilty of unprofessional conduct or professional incompetency.”
8. K.S.A § 65-1626(ccc) defines “unprofessional conduct” as “conduct likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public.”

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent’s application for registration as a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas is hereby DENIED.

NOTICES

Respondent is hereby notified as follows:


1. Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas State Administrative Procedures Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231, within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Summary Order shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. § 77-529.
4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. § 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to § 77-613. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
