SUMMARY ORDER

NOW this _____ day of December, 2012, the above captioned matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") on the application of Jeffrey Vaughn ("Respondent") for a Pharmacy Technician Registration. After considering the foregoing, the Board's Investigative Member, in accordance with the authority granted to him by the Board, enters the following Summary Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has the authority to grant Respondent a Pharmacy Technician Registration.
- 2. On October 22, 2012, Respondent applied for a Pharmacy Technician Registration with the Board.
- 3. The Kansas Bureau of Investigation did a criminal background search on Respondent and provided the Board with an Abstract of Criminal History, more commonly known as the RAP Sheet.
- 4. Respondent's RAP Sheet documented the following arrests, charges and convictions pertinent to Respondent's application for registration as a pharmacy technician:

- a. February 24, 2008: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs (violation of K.S.A. 8-1567).
- b. February 24, 2008: Possession of a Hallucinogenic (violation of K.S.A. 65-4162).
- c. October 3, 2010: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs (violation of K.S.A. 8-1567).
- d. June 30, 2011: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs 3rd Offense; Felony (violation of K.S.A. 8-1567)
- 5. Pursuant to K.S.A. § 65-1663(e)(1), the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the Board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. § 65-1627, and amendments thereto.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A. § 65-1627(a)(2), the Board may deny a license when "the licensee has been convicted of a felony and the licensee fails to show that the licensee has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust."
- 7. Pursuant to K.S.A. § 65-1627(a)(3), the Board may deny a license when "the licensee is found by the Board to be guilty of unprofessional conduct or professional incompetency."
- 8. K.S.A § 65-1626(ccc) defines "unprofessional conduct" as "conduct likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public."

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's application for registration as a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas is hereby DENIED.

NOTICES

Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

- 1. Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas State Administrative Procedures Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231, within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
- 2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Summary Order shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. § 77-529.
- 4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. § 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to § 77-613. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
