# SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 22 day of February, 2017, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Shannon Oliver, ("Respondent"), concerning her pharmacy technician registration.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the application materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

For purposes of this order, the Board's Investigative Member makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. On August 30, 2016, the Kansas Bureau of Investigation provided a notification that on August 27, 2012, Respondent was arrested for misdemeanor stealing.
- 2. On September 22, 2016, the Board sent a letter to Respondent requesting submission of a Form S-150: Personal History to explain the Respondent's offense.

In the Matter of Shannon Oliver, No. 16-167 SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION Page 1 of 5 3. On December 28, 2016, the Board sent a second letter to Respondent requesting submission of a Form S-150: Personal History to explain the Respondent's offese. A deadline

of January 28, 2017 for submission of the S-150 was given.

4. To date, the Board has not received a completed S-150 Personal History form

from Respondent or any correspondence.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** 

5. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663, the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a

registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy

technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of

a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

6. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(3), The Board may revoke the license of a

pharmacist if the licensee is found by the board to be guilty of unprofessional conduct or

professional incompetency.

7. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1626(ccc)(7), unprofessional conduct means conduct

likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public.

8. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15), the Board may revoke the license of a

pharmacist if the licensee has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives

any information legally requested by the board.

9. Respondent's arrest and lack of explanation or evidence of rehabilitation is a

basis to revoke Respondent's pharmacy technician registration for failure to comply with

K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(3).

10. Respondent's failure to provide the Board with legally requested information

concerning applicant's felony arrest via the Form S-150 Personal History is a basis to revoke

### **ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's licensure renewal is hereby REVOKED.

#### **NOTICES**

Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

- 11. Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
- 12. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking Respondent's Registration as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 13. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
- 14. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
