SUMMARY ORDER OF DENIAL

NOW, on this 7th day of March 2022, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Stephanie Minor ("Applicant"), for application for a Kansas pharmacy technician registration.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Denial in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the application materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions, and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On June 7, 2021, the Board received Applicant's application for registration as a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Applicant's Application").
- 2. As part of the application, Applicant answered "NO" to the question: *Have you ever been charged with or convicted of (includes plea of guilty or no contest) a criminal offense or is there any criminal charge now pending against you (other than minor traffic violations) in any state or federal court whether or not a sentence was imposed, suspended, or diverted? This includes misdemeanors.* The application directs that if the applicant answers "YES", they must attach a Form S-150: Personal History ("S-150").

- 3. As part of the application, Applicant had certified that the information provided in the Application was true, correct, and complete, to the best of her knowledge.
- 4. Subsequently, the Board received information regarding a grand theft charge that had been laid against Applicant in 2014.
- 5. On July 2, 2021, the Board sent a letter to Applicant's address of record requesting a completed S-150 as well as certified copies of the court pleadings from the case.
- 6. On or about August 2, 2021, Applicant requested of the Board an extension of the deadline by which to submit the requested documents, which the Board granted.
- 7. On September 14, 2021, the Board had still not received Applicant's documents, and so mailed a second letter to Applicant, again requesting her S-150 and court documentation.
- 8. On October 12, 2021, the Board received from Applicant an email request for another extension of her submission deadline. The Board granted Applicant's request, now set for November 15, 2021.
- 9. On November 18, 2021, the Board received from Applicant her S-150 and a letter of recommendation. Applicant's statement outlined that she had stolen from her employer and was placed on 2-year probation with 200 hours of community service for the grand theft charge. Applicant had included no court documentation to support the charge or the outcome described.
- 10. On January 20, 2022, the Board mailed a final letter to Applicant, requesting her court documents one final time.
 - 11. To date, the Board has not received any court documentation from Applicant.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663(f)(1), the Board may deny an application for issuance of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the Board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15), the Board may deny an application of any license of any pharmacist upon a finding that the licensee has failed to furnish to the Board, its investigators, or its representatives any information legally requested by the Board.

3. Applicant's failure to supply the Board with the court documents requested to complete her Application is a basis to deny Applicant's Application pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Applicant's Application is hereby DENIED.

NOTICES

The Applicant is hereby notified as follows:

- 1. Applicant may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.
- 2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.
- 3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
