SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING LICENSE REGISTRATION

NOW on this 20 day of March, 2018, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Addison Naylor, Pharmacy Technician (“Respondent”).

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board’s Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board’s Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-15893 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas (“Respondent’s Registration”).
2. On February 8, 2018, the Board received a notification from Kansas.gov that Respondent’s October 31, 2017 renewal registration fee in the amount of \$20.00 using a credit card that was returned after processing.

3. On February 13, 2018 the Board requested that Respondent submit a new \$20.00 renewal registration fee plus a \$30.00 returned check fee payment on or before March 15, 2018.

4. To date, the Board has not received a new registration renewal fee payment from Respondent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663(b) each application for pharmacy technician shall be accompanied by an application fee affixed by the Board as provided in K.S.A. 665-1645.

6. Upon applying for her pharmacy technician registration, Respondent paid electronically using a card that was either inactive or had insufficient funds.

7. To date, Respondent has failed to furnish the Board with any information regarding the failed payment and has failed to provide a new renewal application payment to the Board. The Respondent's lack of response and failure to remit the proper registration fee is grounds for revocation of her pharmacy technician registration.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED. Further, the Board orders that Respondent should be and hereby is assessed a total fee of **\$50.00** (\$20.00 in costs plus \$30.00 returned check fee) which shall be paid to the Board by **April 20, 2018**.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

8. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy,

9. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.


10. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

11. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:


