



NOW, ON THIS 18th day of November, 1988, the Kansas State Board of Pharmacy, hereinafter referred as "Board," and James North hereby stipulate and agree to the following terms and conditions:


1. James North shall be on probation from violation of the Kansas Pharmacy Act and/or the Kansas Uniform Controlled Substances Act for a period of one (1) year.

2. James North shall obtain and maintain his own personal law book.


2. James North shall take and pass the open book pharmacy law exam with the normally required passing score of ninety-five (95).

4. Upon receipt of this voluntary stipulation and agreement, and completion of the contents hereof, no further formal proceedings pertinent to this complaint against Mr. North will be pursued by the Board.
