# FINAL AGENCY ORDER

On June 12, 2007, the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") held a hearing on the Application of Jay Parker ("Parker") for registration as a Pharmacy Technician. Parker appeared in person and through his attorney Darin M. Conklin of Alderson, Alderson, Weiler, Conklin, Burghart & Crow, LLC. Randall J. Forbes of Frieden & Forbes acted as the Board's Disciplinary Counsel. After considering the evidence admitted at the hearing, the Board enters the following final agency order.

#### I. FINDING OF FACT

- On September 12, 2006, the Board held a hearing on a disciplinary petition filed by the Board's Disciplinary Counsel against Parker. Following the hearing, the Board issued a Final Agency Order revoking Parker's Kansas license to practice pharmacy.
- On May 4, 2007, the Board received an application from Parker requesting his Kansas license to practice pharmacy be reinstated.
- 3. By a letter dated June 7, 2007, Parker's attorney advised the Board that Parker was withdrawing his application for reinstatement of his pharmacist license and making application for registration as a pharmacy technician. Parker submitted an application for registration as a Pharmacy Technician.

### II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND FACT

Parker's application for registration as a pharmacy technician should be approved.

#### III. FINAL ORDER

Based upon the evidence introduced at the hearing held June 12, 2007 and the foregoing findings and conclusions, Parker's application for registration as a pharmacy technician is hereby granted.

Within fifteen (15) days after service of this Final Agency Order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of this Final Agency Order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
