STIPULATION OF FINDING OF FACT AND ORDER

This matter comes before the State Board of Pharmacy for the State of Kansas, this day of November, 1997.

The State Board of Pharmacy appears by Barry Sarvis,

President and Presiding Officer; Lori Moore, Vice-President;

Dan Katzer, Pharmacist; Vicki Schmidt, Pharmacist; Karla

Kneebone, Pharmacist; and Dan Upson, D.V.M., Consumer

Representative. Also appearing are Larry Froelich, Executive

Secretary, and the attorney for the Board, Dana W. Killinger.

John R. Roesle appears personally.

John R. Roesle states that he has been advised of his procedural rights under the Pharmacy Practice Act and Administrative Procedure Act, wherein counsel for the Board advised John R. Roesle of his rights to a formal hearing wherein he had a right to be represented by counsel, call witnesses on his behalf, cross-examine the Board's witnesses and other procedural rights. Counsel further advised John R. Roesle of the statutory sections of the

law which were allegedly violated and the statute giving the Board jurisdiction in this matter. Whereupon John R. Roesle waived his right to a Formal Hearing.

John R. Roesle further states that no issue of fact exists and wishes to stipulate to the following findings of fact and accepts the order of the State Board of Pharmacy, to-wit:

- 1. John R. Roesle is a licensed pharmacist in the State of Kansas, having License No. 1-10898.
- 2. That John R. Roesle is the Pharmacist in Charge at Mid-American Rehabilitation Pharmacy, Registration No. 2-07475, located at 5701 W. 110th Street, Overland Park, KS 66211.
- 3. That on August 1, 1997, John R. Roesle had not paid his license renewal fee nor furnished evidence to the Board that he successfully completed the required C.E.'s that must be submitted with the license renewal application. K.S.A. 65-1632(a).
- 4. That from July 1 to August 19, 1997, as the PIC of record for Mid-American Rehabilitation Pharmacy, said John R. Roesle was practicing pharmacy with a void and/or inactive license, K.A.R. 68-1-1a(a).
 - 5. That sometime in 1997, said John R. Roesle changed

his residence from 7334 Roe Circle, Prairie Village, Kansas to 8615 Marty, Overland Park, Kansas, and did not notify the Executive Secretary in writing within 30 days. A violation of K.S.A. 65-1633.

The State Board of Pharmacy for the State of Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(8) has jurisdiction and power to revoke, suspend or place on probation and pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, fine said John R. Roesle.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that John R. Roesle, License

No. 1-10898, be fined #50.00 for a violation of paragraph 3

and #50.00 for violation of paragraph 4 for a total

of #100.00, and to take the law exam within 30 days

with a score of not less than 85%.
