FINAL AGENCY ORDER

On July 25, 2014, the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") held a hearing on the allegations that Haley Sneed ("Sneed"), while acting as a pharmacy technician stole controlled substances and cash from her employer. Sneed did/did not appear in person. Randall J. Forbes of Frieden, Unrein & Forbes, LLP appeared as the Board's Disciplinary Counsel. After considering the evidence admitted at the hearing, the Board enters the following final agency order.

I. FINDING OF FACT

- 1. The Board previously issued Sneed Kansas Pharmacy Technician registration number 14-14512, which entitled her to engage in the practice of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas.
- 2. On May 22, 2014, Sneed signed a written statement admitting that while acting as a pharmacy technician at the Walgreen at 510 E. 30th Street in Hutchinson, Kansas she stole cash, Alprazolam and Hydrocodone, which drugs she gave to another person to sell. Her actions constituted the unlawful possession of drugs and the diversion of drugs to another person.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND FACT

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663(e)(1) the Board may take disciplinary action, including revocation, against the registration of a pharmacy technician on any grounds which would authorize the Board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627 and amendments thereto.
- 2. Pursuant to 65-1627(a)(3), the Board can take disciplinary action against the Kansas license of a pharmacist for unprofessional conduct. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1626 (ccc)(5), unprofessional conduct includes the unlawful possession of drugs and the unlawful diversion of drugs to others.
- 3. As a result of Sneed's theft of cash and drugs from her employer and the delivery of the stolen drugs to another person for sale, she is guilty of the unlawful possession of drugs and the unlawful diversion of drugs to others and the Board can revoke her Kansas pharmacy technician registration.

III. FINAL ORDER

Based upon the evidence introduced at the hearing held July 25, 2014 and the foregoing findings and conclusions, Sneed's Kansas pharmacy technician registration is hereby REVOKED.

Within fifteen (15) days after service of this Final Agency Order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of this Final Agency Order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
