# SUMMARY ORDER OF DENIAL

NOW on this 22 day of March, 2017, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the application of 1 Stop Pharmacy, Inc. ("Respondent") for registration as a Non-Resident Pharmacy.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Denial in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the application materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

For purposes of this order, the Board's Investigative Member makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. Respondent is currently registered as a resident pharmacy in Texas.
- 2. On January 10, 2017, the Board received Respondent's application for registration as a non-resident pharmacy in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Renewal Application").

- 3. On February 14, 2017, the Board notified Respondent that there was an incomplete required portion on the submitted application requesting an Inspection Report within the last two years.
- 4. On March 1, 2017, the Board made several attempts to contact the owner and pharmacy at the phone numbers listed in the Application. All listed numbers were non-working.
- 5. On March 2, 2017, the Board sent Respondent a Final Notice letter, requesting the missing Inspection Report described above, and requesting a working 1-800 contact number for the pharmacy, to be received by the Board no later than March 17, 2017.
- 6. To date, the Board has not received any contact or requested documentation from Respondent.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 7. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1643(a), a pharmacy wishing to operate in the State of Kansas shall remain in full compliance with the law and rules and regulations of the Board.
- 8. That pursuant to K.S.A. 68-7-12a(g), the pharmacy shall maintain an incoming toll-free telephone number for use by Kansas customers to facilitate personal communication with a pharmacist with access to patient records.
- 9. That pursuant to K.S.A. 68-7-12a(i), the facilities and records of the pharmacy shall be subject to inspection by the Board, with inspections requiring similar standards as the Board being allowed.
- 10. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15), an applicant shall provide the Board with any information legally requested.

11. Respondent's failure to provide a working toll-free telephone number for prospective Kansas customers is a basis to deny Respondent's application pursuant to K.S.A. 68-7-12a(g).

12. Respondent's failure to provide a previous inspection result to the Board is a basis to deny Respondent's application pursuant to K.S.A. 68-7-12a(i).

13. Respondent's failure to provide the Board with a working telephone number or inspection reports per request by the Board is a basis to deny Respondent's application.

### **ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Renewal Application is hereby DENIED.

#### **NOTICES**

Applicant is hereby notified as follows:

14. Applicant may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

15. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order denying Respondent's Registration as a non-resident pharmacy shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

16. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

17. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
