# **SUMMARY ORDER**

NOW on this 22 day of April, 2019 comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Medi-Fare Drug Pharmaceutical Compounding (5-109213) ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board has previously issued Respondent Registration No. 5-106426 which entitles Respondent to operate as a wholesale distributor in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On November 20, 2018, ownership of Respondent's facility was transferred from Medi-Fare Drug Pharmaceutical Compounding to Medi-Fare Drug Pharmaceutical Compounding, LLC.

- 3. On April 12, 2019, the Board received from Respondent a Form BA-05 Registration Application, notifying of the change in ownership, effective November 20, 2018, and applying for a new wholesale distributor registration under the new ownership.
- 4. On April 16, 2019, the Board issued Respondent a new registration under the new ownership (5-109213).

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, the Board may assess a civil fine not to exceed \$5,000, after notice and an opportunity to be heard, to any registrant for violation of the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas or any other rules or regulations of the state board of pharmacy.
- 6. Pursuant to K.A.R. 68-2-9, each registrant shall notify the executive secretary of the board in writing of any change in majority ownership of the operation for which the registration was issued within five days after the date the change in ownership becomes effective.
- 7. Respondent had five days to notify the Board of the change in ownership, effective November 20, 2018, or until November 25, 2018.
- 8. Respondent failed to notify the Board until April 12, 2019, which several months beyond the five-day window for notification to the Board.
- 9. Respondent violated K.A.R. 68-2-9 when failing to notify the Board of a change in majority ownership within five days.

ORDER

The Board finds and concludes that Respondent's conduct, as described above, violates

the Act and such conduct warrants the imposition of a fine pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, in the

amount of \$500.00. Respondent has 30 days from the date of this order to pay the full \$500.00.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative 1.

Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson,

Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order shall become a final

order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a

petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial

review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive
