SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 2nd day of April, 2015, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Investigation Member, the matter of OK Compounding, LLC ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board's Investigation Member enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Investigative Member makes the following findings of fact:

1. On July 8, 2013, the Board issued Respondent Non-Resident Pharmacy Registration Number 22-13045 authorizing it to ship, mail and/or deliver prescription drugs to patients in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").

2. On June 12, 2014, the Oklahoma Board of Pharmacy issued an order disciplining Respondent's Oklahoma Pharmacy Registration by placing it on probation for

three (3) years, ordering Respondent to pay a fine of \$520,200.00 and ordering Respondent to cease operations for a period of five (5) days (“Oklahoma Disciplinary Action”).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627 (e)(4) the Board may revoke, suspend or place on probationary status the registration of a pharmacy if the registrant pharmacy has had disciplinary action taken against its pharmacy registration in another state.

4. The Oklahoma Disciplinary Action is a sufficient basis to revoke Respondent’s Registration.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent’s Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

5. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

6. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the Respondent’s Registration as a non-resident pharmacy shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.


7. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

8. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
