**SUMMARY ORDER**

NOW on this 5th day of October, 2021, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the “Board”), through its Executive Director, the matter of Right Way Medical, LLC (“Respondent”).

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board’s Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Board has previously issued Respondent Registration No. 5-103874 which entitles Respondent to operate as a wholesale distributor in the State of Kansas (“Respondent’s Registration”).
2. On February 1, 2020, the address of Respondent’s facility was changed from 510-E Wilson Bridge Road, Suite H, Worthington Ohio (“Old Address”) to 835 Green Crest Drive, Westerville, Ohio (“New Address”).
3. On June 15, 2020, the Board received Respondent’s renewal application for Respondent’s Registration at it’s Old Address, which was approved on June 18, 2020. On the

renewal application, Respondent certified that everything was “true, correct, and complete, to the best of [Respondent’s] knowledge.

4. On June 7, 2021, the Board received from Respondent a Form BA-05 Wholesale Distributor Registration Application, notifying of the change in address to the New Address, effective February 1, 2020, and applying for a new wholesale distributor registration at the New Address.

5. On June 10, 2021, the Board approved Respondent’s Wholesale Distributor Application, effective immediately.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, the Board may assess a civil fine not to exceed \$5,000, after notice and an opportunity to be heard, to any registrant for violation of the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas or any other rules or regulations of the state board of pharmacy.

2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(f)(6), the Board may take action against a registration of a wholesale distributor that has violated the Pharmacy Act of the State of Kansas or regulations adopted by the Board.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 68-14-4(c), each registrant must submit change in address information within 30 days after any change in that information.

4. Respondent’s failure to submit the complete change of address application to the Board until June 7, 2021 – over a year past the March 2, 2020 deadline – is a violation of K.S.A. 68-14-4(c), and a basis to discipline Respondent’s Registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(f)(6).

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1643, it shall be unlawful for any person to distribute at wholesale any drugs without first obtaining a registration as a wholesale distributor from the Board.

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1645(f), registrations issued pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1643 shall not be transferrable and shall expire every year.

7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(f)(1), the Board may take action against a registration of a wholesale distributor that has renewed a registration by false or fraudulent means, including misrepresentation of a material fact or falsification of any application.

8. By continuing to operate as a wholesale distributor at the New Address using the registration issued to the Old Address, Respondent violated K.S.A. 65-1643.

9. By renewing Respondent's Registration in 2020 using the Old Address, Respondent materially misrepresented the physical and operational location of the facility on a renewal application, which was approved by the Board and is a basis to discipline Respondent's Registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(f)(1).

#### ORDER

The Board finds and concludes that Respondent's conduct, as described above, violates the Act and such conduct warrants the imposition of a fine pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, in the amount of \$1,500. Respondent has 30 days from the date of this order to pay the full amount due.

#### NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

1. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
