IV. KDHE Overdose Data Presentation	Scott Johnston, MPH, Epidemiologist, provided an overview of recent prescription drug-related overdose data. Committee members asked for additional data related to gender breakdowns.
V. KOMA/KORA Training	Randy Forbes, Board Attorney, provided an overview of Kansas Open Meetings and Kansas Open Records Act for the committee.
