SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

NOW on this 27day of April, 2018, comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Mandie Ackerman, Pharmacy Technician ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Summary Order of Revocation in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

For purposes of this order, the Board's Executive Secretary makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Board has previously issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-101940 authorizing her to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On or about April 11, 2018, the Board received a C-100 Complaint Form from the Pharmacist in Charge of Dillons Pharmacy #25 stating Respondent admitted to the theft of

Tramadol from the pharmacy and that she was arrested by the Hutchinson Police Department on the same date.

- 3. On or about April 17, 2018, the Board received a DEA Form 106, reporting the theft of 206 Tramadol 50mg from Dillons Pharmacy #25.
- 4. On or about April 17, 2018, the Board received a signed statement from Respondent, admitting to taking the Tramadol.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 5. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1663 the Board may limit, suspend, or revoke a registration or deny an application for issuance or renewal of any registration as a pharmacy technician on any ground which would authorize the board to take action against the license of a pharmacist under K.S.A. 65-1627, and amendments thereto.
- 6. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(3), the Board may take action against the license of a pharmacist who has been found guilty of unprofessional conduct.
- 7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1626(sss), unprofessional conduct includes unlawful possession of drugs and conduct likely to deceive or harm the public.
- 8. Respondent's diversion of 206 Tramadol 50mg is both unlawful possession of drugs and conduct likely to harm the public, and therefore is unprofessional conduct and grounds to revoke Respondent's pharmacy technician registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(3).

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, Respondent's Registration is hereby REVOKED.

NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

9. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas

Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy,

800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of

this order.

10. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order revoking the

Respondent's Registration, as a pharmacy technician shall become a final order of the Board,

effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

11. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file

a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

12. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek

judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated
