# AMENDED SUMMARY ORDER

NOW on this 19th day of December, 2019 comes before the Kansas Board of Pharmacy (the "Board"), through its Executive Secretary, the matter of Gloria Adams ("Respondent").

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Pharmacy Act, K.S.A. 65-1625, et seq., and in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board's Executive Secretary enters this Amended Summary Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the investigation materials and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board has issued Respondent Pharmacy Technician Registration Number 14-17039 authorizing Respondent to perform the functions of a pharmacy technician in the State of Kansas ("Respondent's Registration").
- 2. On April 30, 2019, the Board mailed Respondent a summary order imposing a fine of \$50.00 due within 30 days and proof of 4 hours of continuing education (CE) due within 60 days for failure to complete the required CE during an audited period.
- 3. On July 5, 2019, the Board sent a letter to Respondent's address of record requesting payment of the past-due fine and proof of the past-due CE within 30 days.

- 4. On September 19, 2019, the Board emailed a Final Notice to Respondent's address of record requesting the past-due fine and CE.
- 5. On December 19, 2019, the Board received additional information concerning Respondent's continuing education hours and providing proof of sufficient hours to meet the renewal requirements.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658, the Board may assess a civil fine not to exceed \$5,000, after notice and an opportunity to be heard, to any registrant for violation of the pharmacy act of the state of Kansas or any other rules or regulations of the state board of pharmacy.
- 2. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(16), the licensee has violated or failed to comply with any lawful order or directive of the board.
- 3. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15), the licensee has failed to furnish the board, its investigators or its representatives any information legally requested by the board.
- 4. Respondent's failure to comply with the previous Summary Order and respond to requests from the board for proof of completion of the CE hours and compliance with the Summary Order are bases to discipline Respondent's Registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1627(a)(15) and (16) and assess a fine pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1658.

#### **ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Board finds Respondent was in compliance with the continuing education requirements for renewal, but failed to respond to the Board's requests for information and comply with the Summary Order. Therefore, Respondent is ordered to pay a \$100 fine to the Board within 30 days from the date of this order.

### NOTICES

The Respondent is hereby notified as follows:

1. The Respondent may request a hearing pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act by filing a written request with the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, 800 SW Jackson, Suite 1414, Topeka, KS 66612-1231 within fifteen (15) days after service of this order.

2. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the Order shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing.

3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

4. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
